As you may know, we offer a live-in program where we minister to women who need help dealing with difficult life challenges such as grief, anxiety, depression, trauma, and loss. To provide a safe place for them to come and receive counseling for healing and wholeness through God's word, we have real physical needs; housing, food, utilities, auto expenses, insurance, etc. All things necessary to run a "household."

In addition, we open our doors to minister to our community through our biblical counseling center, offering hope and guidance for those in dire circumstances. Administrative costs, educational materials for clients, staff salaries, telephone and internet charges are part of our essential overhead.

It is our responsibility to prepare and adhere to a budget that will cover the necessary expenses associated with running a busy and worthwhile ministry. We also forecast what monetary needs will be necessary to cover these costs. Our goal is to generate enough funds to cover our expenses.

The fact that costs have skyrocketed has made this 2024 budget particularly challenging. This ministry always aims to be good stewards of the giftings and contributions we receive as well as being transparent about how the money is being spent.

While stripping away any excess and basing the income on previous years, our budget is almost \$50,000.00 in the red.

We know God has always provided for the Refuge and will continue to do so if He deems it. We believe in transparency, letting our supporters know the situation we face. Many of you have faithfully given over the years, although some have never given. We ask you now, even if it's your first or fiftieth time reading our newsletter, to make a one-time donation to help us meet the monthly bills. Even a small contribution makes a difference in the lives of women, men, and families seeking help.

Our hearts are open to the hurting as we minister with the gospel of Jesus Christ and we desire to keep the doors open to all who come seeking hope, help, and healing from life's difficulties.


Shelter from the Storm (Women's Study): This class
